- Volunteers shall work with students under the immediate supervision and direction of a JRCS staff member.
- Volunteers likely to be involved in one-to-one situations with children on a frequent basis hold positions of trust. Accordingly, we ask that the volunteer submit a set of fingerprints at their own expense and a notarized form with information about felony or misdemeanor convictions.
- Volunteers who donate their time in schools are covered by the Volunteer Liability Act (1997), which covers volunteers who are acting within the scope of their responsibilities. The Act does not cover willful or criminal acts of negligence or omission, or harm caused while operating a motor vehicle.
- Volunteers who will be driving students for a same day or overnight field trips must complete the following steps:
  - Must be at least 21 year of age
  - Complete the background / fingerprint process with CBI & D51 at the volunteers own expense
  - Complete Insurance and Driver Information form (see attached form)
  - Provide current proof of Insurance
  - Current registration information for the vehicle
  - Provide a valid Colorado Driver’s License
